Pin Pal Monthly

The **June** pinwheel is due this month. Twenty 3.5" pinwheel blocks should be spinning in the direction of the photo. June color is YELLOW along with a neutral.

Check the direction of the pinwheels. They should look like the photo below. Also make sure to trim the "ears" from the triangles to get a flat tiny pinwheel on the back of the block.

Monthly colors are: April/green, May/pink, June/yellow, July/red, August/purple, Sept/rust, Oct/orange, Nov/gray and Dec/blue.



Please use a good quality quilting fabric and no "conversation" prints.
